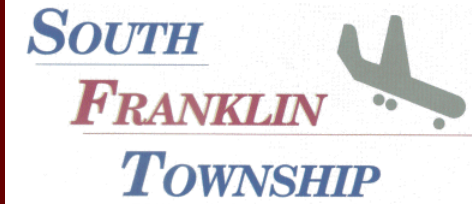

## New Ordinance Information

Per ordinance 160-8 of the Township, all residences must post their house number clearly on the house, mailbox or post. Numbers must be Arabic figures at least three inches high and one-half inch wide. Reflective number signs are available for purchase at the VFD for a nominal fee. ## Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance

The Township is undertaking a joint project with Green Hills to update our Zoning and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinances. The current Ordinances are very outdated and need to be redeveloped to accommodate potential growth within the Township and surrounding areas. Mackin Engineering has been hired to complete the updating of the Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance. Notifications of public meetings will be advertised in the Observer-Reporter and at the Township building.
